Suggestions	Responses
<b>Facilities</b>	
<p>Can we please get a food or healthy juice truck to come onto campus during lunch break?</p>	<p>We have had food trucks on campus in the past. However, not enough students were purchasing from them to make it worth their while. If you know of a food truck that is interested in coming on campus, we would allow it at no charge. They would just need to coordinate with the college president.</p>
<p>MTI should hold the graduation ceremony in a bigger facility to accommodate more friends and family members of graduates. I personally would not mind if tuition was raised a few hundred dollars more to help pay to rent a bigger place to hold the graduation ceremonies.</p>	<p>Unfortunately, the next biggest facility would far exceed the number of people we would have attend and would make for a seemingly empty ceremony. We will look into alternative room configurations at our current facility to see if we can somehow accommodate more guests.</p>
<p>I often get to school 10 minutes before my first class (sometimes i come earlier) and my first class starts at 10:30. there's often never parking but there's always at least 4 cars that are taking up multiple spots. The security guard should be able to give tickets for double parking because it wastes so much space and it's very inconvenient.</p>	<p>The security guard is on-campus during the afternoons and evening.
