

Smoking and Tobacco Use

All forms of smoking and tobacco use, including e-cigarettes, are prohibited inside the school buildings and are permitted **only** in designated outside smoking areas where receptacles are located. See the map on the back cover. This policy includes, but is not limited to, all tobacco products such as cigarettes, cigars and chewing tobacco, and to electronic (or vapor) cigarettes. Please help us keep the campus grounds clean by disposing of cigarette butts in the proper receptacles and not on the ground or in the flowerbeds.

MTI Campus Smoking Policy

If you are a smoker, we thank you for observing MTI's established smoking rules while on campus.

1) Since MTI operates non-smoking buildings, **any** smoking should be done out-of-doors and **only** in one of the two (2) designated smoking areas.

2) Cigarette butts do not belong on the ground. We do not wish to see them litter our beautiful campus. They are to be placed only in the designated containers.

Additional Comments

Along with observing MTI's smoking policy, there are two additional comments we would like to make regarding smoking and courtesy to non-smokers.

If you have been smoking in your car or some other enclosed place before arriving at MTI, please be sensitive to the odors from smoking that may follow you into the classrooms and offices. These odors can be distressing to non-smokers.
