

Hello MTI Students,

With changes coming to our local and state guidelines regarding social distancing, MTI has begun planning for returning to campus. I know many of you will have questions about what exactly this means and how it will impact you and your classes going forward. I assure you that as soon as we have more information available, we will be sharing it with you.

Currently, the only classes regularly offered on campus are in the medical program when students begin clinical courses. These classes will remain on campus. However, with June 15th as the date of California's reopening, we hope to bring additional classes back to campus as well. The process of returning to in-person classes will be a gradual one, beginning as soon as our June term on Monday, June 28th.

For the June term, MTI plans to bring keyboarding classes back to campus as well. At this time, we are unsure of what policies will be in place, but we will be abiding by all local and state regulations. You can also expect additional classes to return to campus for our August term on Monday, August 9th. We have not made final determinations yet about which classes will be returning to campus for August, but we will update you once this information is available.

Key Points:

- Current on-campus classes will remain on campus.
- Keyboarding classes will return to campus on June 28th.
